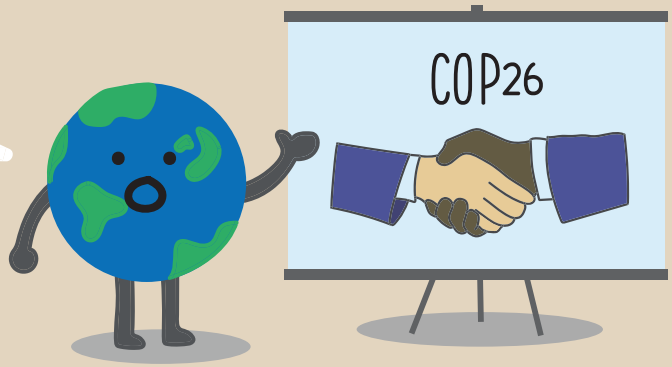


# 9 WAYS TOWARDS CLIMATE JUSTICE

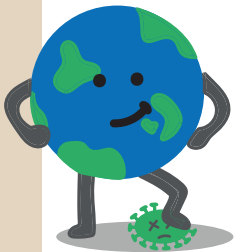
